<i>Richard Lee</i>	
Richard Lee was born March 22, 1617/18 and died 1664 in Jamestown, Virginia. He married Anne Constable 1637 in London England. Richard came to Virginia from Stratford Langdon, in Essex, England in 1638 aboard the "Alexander." He was the colonial Secretary of State in 1642 and was in the House of Burgess from 1647 until 1651.

<i>Charles Lee</i>	<i>Richard Lee</i>
Charles was the youngest child of Richard. He was born in 1656 in "Cobb's Hall" in Northumberland County, Virginia and died in 1702. He married Elizabeth Medstand in 1676. Charles was a Justice for Northumberland County from 1687 until 1699. Charles and Elizabeth had two daughters and	Richard Lee was the second oldest child of Richard Lee and Anne Constable. He married Latitia Corbin.

<i>Thomas Lee</i>	<i>Henry Lee</i>
Thomas Lee was the youngest child of Charles. He was born 1679 and died 1735. Thomas married Elizabeth Keene in 1700. Elizabeth was the daughter of William Keene and Elizabeth Rogers.
