(Isle of Wight Ca VA marriage records)

Thomas Flood married Elizabeth Gale Jan 13 1787, in Isle of Wight Co VA (Isle of Wright Co. marriage records)

(Isle of Wight Co VA wills)

The will of Thomas Whitney Gale: Leg. son, Thomas; granddaughter, Polly Flood; daughter, Polly; daughter, Sally; wife, Sarah. Exs., son, Thomas Gale and Edward Davis.

D. November 8 1791. R. December 6, 1791.

Wit: Edward Davis, Everett Morris, Penelope Pope

Security: Thomas Davis and Edward Davis

Thomas Flood first bought land in Wilson Co. TN 2-8-1800

Note: Could Edward & Thomas Davis be kin of Thomas Flood's mother?

Page 2 - May 2 1806.....Polly Thomas Flood to John Stockard

(Page 295 of book 1802-1814 wills & inventories.....Wilson Co TN)

Commissioners laid off to Judith Flood, widow of Thomas Flood dec'd, her dower. or one third of the lands, her husband Thomas Flood died seized of. Commissioners were: James Thompson, James Campbell, John Adams, William Richards, James Williams, A.K. Bryan, John Armstrong, William W. Porterfield, Thomas Bone, Isaac Witherspoon. Neal Smith protested. 23rd day of March 1811

Page 24 - Nov 27 1812.....Nancy Flood to Harris Smith

(Page 410 - wills & inventories)

May the 24 1814, the valuation of the personal property of Thomas Flood dec'd and division agreeable to an order of court to allot John Stockard, Harris Smith their proportioned part, there being eight legatees to wit.

1 negro woman named Estes, about 35 years of age, valued to \$303.33 1/3

1 negro boy, named George 13 years old, valued to \$328.33 1/3

1 negro boy, named Dick 9 years old, valued to \$270.00

1 negro boy, named David 5 years old, valued to \$166.66 2/3

1 negro girl, named Caly about 1, valued to \$99.30

1 cow & yearling, valued to \$7.00

Account of money in the hands of Admr: \$500.71 1/2. We find the estate is worth \$1902.04 3/4. The amount received by John Stockard, when married, \$98.50, which

makes in all \$2000.54  $\frac{3}{4}$ . Each legatee's part is \$250.06  $\frac{1}{4}$ . John Stockard, part received when married = \$98.50. John Stockard, part rec'd at the division \$151.06  $\frac{1}{4}$ . Allotted to John Stockard, 1 negro boy, Abram, 3 years old, valued to \$166.66  $\frac{2}{3}$ . Paid up by John Stockard = \$15.10  $\frac{1}{2}$ . Allotted Harris Smith, 1 negro boy, David, 5 years old, valued to 226.66  $\frac{2}{3}$ . Paid up to Harris Smith by Adm = \$23.40  $\frac{1}{2}$ , which makes their proportion of estate.

Page 41 - Jun 1, 1816 Judith Flood to George Michie

(Wilson Co TN Court minutes 1816-1819)

Benjamin bowers vs. George Michie & wife:

On the petition of Benjamin Bower, who was security for Judith Flood (who has intermarried with George Michie) for the guardianship of Elizabeth, Robert, Henry, Lucy, and John Flood, minor heirs of Thomas, setting forth that he is likely to sustain damage by an improper management of the estate of said minor heirs, and the George Michie, being in court, and assenting thereto, it is ordered by the court that the said Benjamin Bowers be discharged from his liability as security for said defendants, and thereupon, George Michie is appointed guardian of said minor heirs, and entered into bond with James Cross, Abner Wasson, William Michie and James Michie, his securities in the penalty of \$5,000 conditioned as the law directs.

The above records prove the names of the wives of Thomas Flood, about when & where he died, the names of his children, and husbands of the 2 oldest. It also proves the name of Judith Flood's 2nd husband. When you don't have documents for something, try to give a good case for why you believe it to be true.
